- Provision of internet connectivity to Public Schools, Government Hospitals and other key Government locations.
- Launch of LASIMRA S-auto platform - an automated commercial platform designed to enable online Permit Process in LASIMRA to foster ease of doing business.

Your endeavour(s) at ensuring that Lagos State ranked among its peers as a vibrant Smart City that is safe, secure and functional is a step in the right direction and LASIMRA looks forward to another amazing and prosperous third year in Office.
